ORDER – IMPOSITION OF OPTIONAL FEES FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2021 PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 502 OF THE TEXAS TRANSPORTATION CODE

WHEREAS, County Commissioners Courts are statutorily required to notify the Texas Department of Motor Vehicles (TxDMV) each year regarding the imposition or removal of optional fees; and

WHEREAS, notice must be made to the TxDMV each year by September 1; and

WHEREAS, the local optional fees that could be imposed, pursuant to Chapter 5 of the Texas Transportation Code are:

- 1) a County Road and Bridge Fee (Section 502.401) and/or
- 2) a Child Safety Fee (Section 502.403):

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Wood County would like to impose above-listed fees for Calendar Year 2021;

ORDER

The Wood County Commissioners Court hereby:

Notifies the Texas Department of Motor Vehicles (TxDMV) of their approval to continue to collect the Road and Bridge Fee currently imposed in the amount of Ten (\$10) Dollars and also of their approval to initiate collection of a Child Safety Fee in amount of One Dollar and Fifty Cents (\$1.50) to take effect January 1, 2021.

This Order constitutes notice to the public.
